



## Student Group Guidelines

Student groups are important to Chanhassen Dinner Theatres. Your young people are our future audience and we enjoy serving them! Here are a few guidelines to ensure a special visit for your group. After you have read through this; please sign, date, and return it with your contract. Thank you!

Please arrive within the stated seating time. To facilitate theatre seating, distribute tickets prior to arrival and have students enter the theatre with their assigned tablemates. Students should remain in their reserved seats to assure the safety of all patrons and service staff.

Allow one adult chaperone for every 20 high school students and one adult for every 10 students ages 11-14. Chaperones: please closely supervise your students' activities. Chaperones will be assigned to specific seats after your final count is received; this assists our staff in finding a chaperone should an emergency occur.

Prepaid gratuity covers inclusive food service and does not cover a la carte items or beverages (other than coffee, hot or iced tea or a first glass of milk). Soft drinks and super sippers are an additional cost item. Your students should be prepared to pay a guest check and include state tax and gratuity for additional items. If you are concerned about students dealing with money at the table, we strongly suggest you consider the Student Package, which includes a refillable Super Sipper (which is also a souvenir), and dessert.

Complimentary Tours or Question & Answer Sessions with actors are available upon request through group sales in advance.

*We've recently had some problems with items. Please go over these with your students to avoid any issues!*

Attending Chanhassen Dinner Theatres is a special event for all of our guests. So in consideration of these guests, please advise your students to dress appropriately and be gracious and respectful audience members.

Text messaging and ALL use of cell phones is strictly prohibited. Phones in use during a performance will be confiscated.

Students may not roam in non-public areas of the theatre. Our building is a fun place to explore, but please be informed that several areas are strictly off limits to members of the public. Dark, unused, or backstage areas, the rooftop, kitchen areas... you are not welcome in these places. If this occurs, a chaperone will be asked to remove the student(s) from the building, and remain with them until the performance has concluded. After the performance, students must not be left unattended while waiting for transportation.
