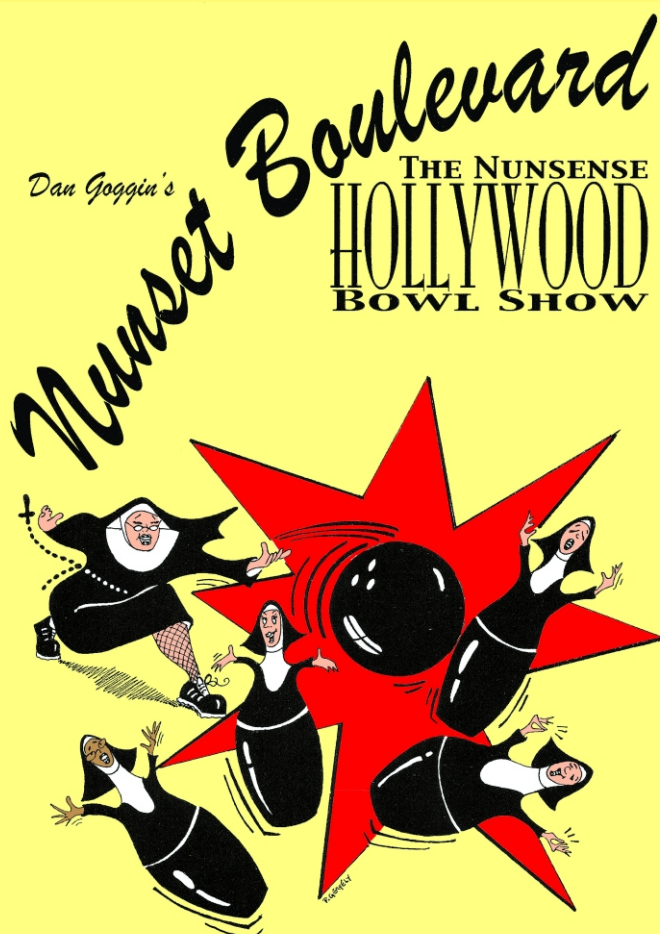




# *Another Nunsense World Premiere comes to Chanhassen Dinner Theatres!*
