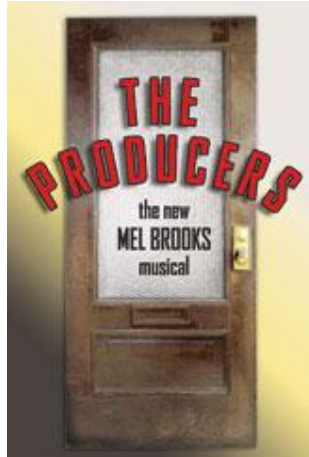

Producer/Director Mel Brooks took a real gamble when he adapted his 1968 film satire to the musical stage. The story was utterly outrageous: flop covered theatrical producer Max Bialystock realizes the road to his financial redemption lies in producing the worst musical ever written, raising 25,000% of the capital, and pocketing it all when the show is a one-night-only disaster. Aided and abetted by a timid accountant, Leo Bloom, Bialystock options the rights to a "gay romp with Adolf and Eva in Berchtesgarden" called "Springtime for Hitler." Of course, if the show, by some insane stretch of credulity, were to become a hit, Bialystock and Bloom would be thrown in jail.

And that's exactly what happens!

Winner of a record-breaking 12 Tony Awards, THE PRODUCERS was remade into a popular movie musical in 2006. It closed on Broadway in April 2007. Chanhassen Dinner Theatres is one of three elite regional theatres in the U.S. to receive the rights to produce
